

COVID-19 regulations

Dear participants,

please take note of our applicable COVID-19 regulations:

A 2,5-G certificate (proof of vaccination/recovery or negative PCR test) is required to attend the course.

G1: Full immunization with a EMA-approved vaccine through two partial vaccinations as well as recovery and vaccination or booster vaccination
2-dose-vaccinations are **valid for 180 days** after the second dose. After that a **booster** jab is required, which is valid for 270 days.

G2: Recovery from an infection with SARS-Cov-2 (PCR-confirmed) - (valid for 180 days).

Anybody who does not meet either the G1 or G2-criteria is required to continuously present PCR tests.

Valid evidence: negative PCR-test, valid for 48 hours from testing-time; the period of validity must cover the entire day of the workshop.

Wearing a **FFP2 mask is mandatory** in **all buildings and areas of the Med Uni Graz.**

In Austria, wearing a **FFP2 mask** is also mandatory in **public transports, public buildings** as well as **shops**.

Please **keep distance (2 meters) whenever possible!**

The **marked one way system in the rooms of the Section of Surgical Research has to be respected!**

Please **wash** and **disinfect** your hands regularly.

If there is a **suspected COVID-19 case during the workshop**, the person will be **tested as soon as possible**. Until the result confirmation, the person concerned will be separated in a special room.

The COVID-19 regulations will be updated according to the national guidelines.
